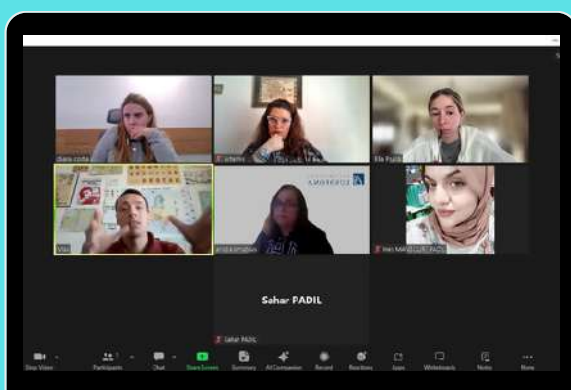


# SEHEME
